Storage tank to store and provide clean water. 4. At planned intervals, inspect/check at site the <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Stainless steel plates are hygienically maintained as per OCPs (b) Storage tank is cleaned and ensure no contaminated ingress is allowed into the tank. (c) Water purifier is cleaned and maintained to provide clean and drinking water. (d) Send random sample of drinking water to lab for analysis and potability. 5. Provide monitoring & measurement reports as per OCPs. 6. Interact with students, parents and teachers to get the feel of facilities provided. 7. Ensure water purifier and storage tanks are well maintained by giving annual maintenance contract. 8. Check on the quality and durability of lunch plates during site inspection.

4. *Easy & clean filling of overhead water tank through motor & piping installed.*
