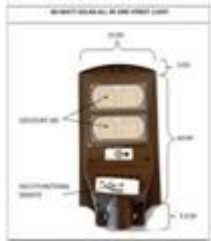
CSR Initiative @ Pune - KINARA VRIDHASHAM FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED & ORPHANED ELDERS



To provide one number Solar Street Light Lamp at Kinara Vridhashram, Kamshet, near Pune, for convenience of orphaned old age people during night time. (This is a fourth one).



Installed integrated 12V Solar Street Light with four meter pole to enable orphaned elders, especially whose eye sight is weak due to aging, to walk to through at night. Vridhasharam at Maval is surrounded by lush green thick bushes with ingress of reptiles and crawling creatures at night. Solar lamp is adjusted with mini electronic control panel to automatically switch off at dawn, get charged during the day and switch on when sun sets. Programmed to adjust according to seasons. This is the 4th one installed by RSB.



CSR Initiative @ Pune – Celebration of Gudi Padva (Maharashtrian New Year) with under-privileged living on road side hutments



Celebrated Gudi Padva, traditional annual Maharashtrian festival(New Year), with have-not under-privileged old, young and children, living on alms and staying at make-shift hutments by distributing Shrikhand, a traditional sweet delicacy, during 2nd Wave of Pandemic.

Masks were distributed. Volunteers from Kasewadi, Vadarwadi, Paravti & Janwadi supported by their physical presence to maintain discipline. A sanitized table was laid with hygienically cloth covered. Every under-privileged was sanitized. Children and old people were given special care.

Everyone was given hygienically factory fresh sealed Shrikhand sweet delicacy tamper-proof pack of 315gms. The table cloth was discarded after sanitising as per Covid protocol. Volunteers wore face shield, double layer mask and hand gloves. All were greeted with wishes in Indian Namaste style keeping social distancing. Every one was regulated in an queue keeping social distancing, keeping in mind Sec 144 is in place to ensure only 5 people at a time come. Our gesture was well received by all beneficiaries and appreciated by law-enforcing agencies.

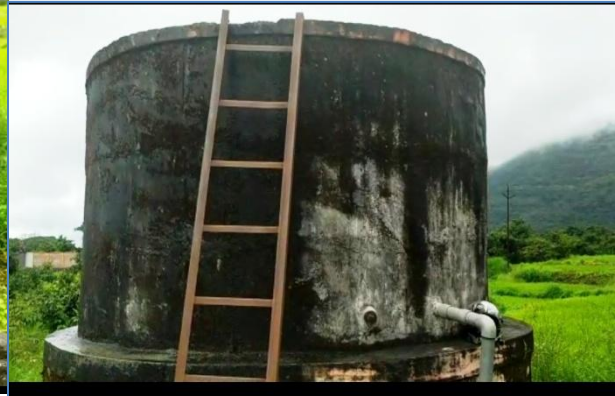

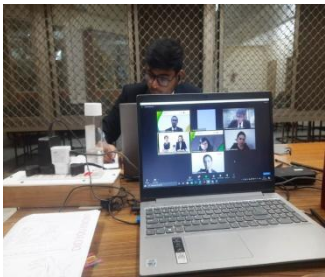

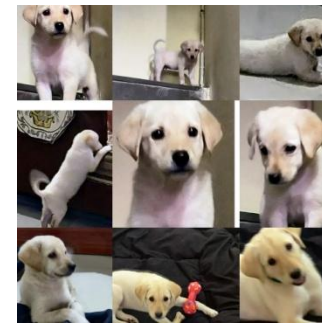
