SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

1. *Proper and ergonomic sitting and writing arrangements for all students.*
2. *Total no. of beneficiaries covered:
Below Poverty Line: 60 (children of two villages with approx. 1500 families)*
3. *Easy & clean filling of overhead water tank through motor & piping installed.*
4. *Water availability – 24/7 through storage/pumping.*
5. *Water wastage eliminated through proper piping.*
6. *Students urinating in the open eliminated and girls students have proper toilet facilities.*
7. *Water accumulation due to spillage on the ground eliminated and hence, no mosquito breeding.*
8. *PVC pipes installed ensure no rusting.*
