Objective → Upliftment of tribal community by giving them adequate free healthcare facilities @ Lakhadia/Badalgoda.(Started in Oct 2004). Provision for Mid-day Meal to Girl Students for Apr-May 20.

Activity → In the villages of Bhagabandi and Badalgoda of [Dumaria Block], interior of Jharkhand (naxal dominated area), RSB conducts free medical camps once a month for under-privileged. Even during Covid19, health camps were conducted and Arsenic Album 30 for Covid prevention were given to under-privileged.. Covid Awareness sessions were conducted. Provisions supplied to School girl students for mid-day meal(Apr-May 20) and had to be stopped due to closure of hostel on account of Covid19.

Company physician & representatives visit these places to provide free medical check-ups, consultancy and medicines to the villagers.

Social Impact Assessment → Till date almost 70,000+ patients have been treated so far. Good recovery.Non-invasive treatment. Due to counselling, healthy eating and living habits inculcated. Covid awareness session conducted in local language . Patients are extremely satisfied with the treatment. Chronic cases are referred to hospitals.

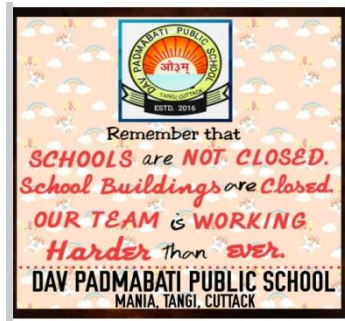

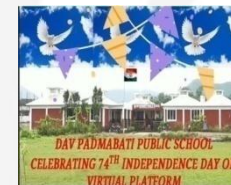

Objective

Education support to Ms Lipsa Rani, a brilliant top ranking under-privileged girl student (stood 2nd in merit in State Board of Odisha) through payment of college and tuition fees and hostel. RSB is helping to fulfil her ambition of becoming honest IAS officer.

Activity

7000 under-privileged women in slums underwent intense on-site Awareness Training about Anemia causes and Prevention with direct interventions to cure 300 women patients of Anemia, to demonstrate the cure for anemia. Women trained on Mental Health Issues and ill-effects of Addictions by doctors and para-medical staff. 120 select Women will go through intense Leadership Development Program and will be the peer leaders for various change initiatives in their respective localities. 175 Daughter-in-laws, coming in the project areas, will be imparted knowledge on Reproductive Health, Better Relationships with families and capacity to cope up with the changed environment.

Social impact assessment

Total of 4000 slum women were trained in various skills, viz Treatment of Anaemia through camps, Leadership Programs, Newly Weds Counselling, Mother-in-law & daughter-in-law counselling Meets, Mental Health Groups, Skill Development for sustenance

Objective

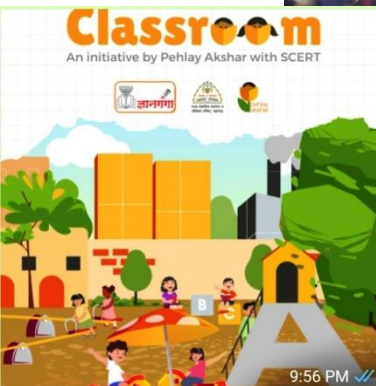
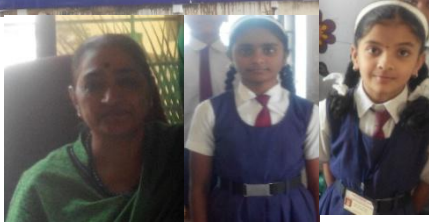

Mr Chetan immediately alighted, helped the old woman with mineral water, got her some food and dropped her at a Boudha temple close-by at Jambhe village where she had taken shelter outside in a dilapidated open veranda exposed to chilling winter. She was living on offerings by devotees visiting the temple and has not taken even a bath for last two months. 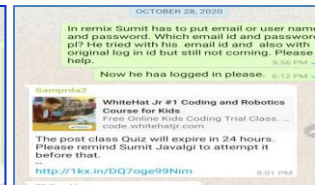
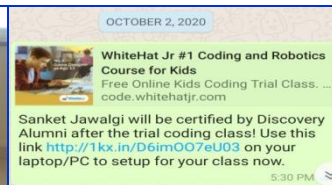
